# PRESCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

Parents of children 3 to 5 years are required to provide an up to date health appraisal & immunization record prior to attending any program.

Parents/guardians requesting an exemption on the basis of religious belief or other objections, should contact their local Health Department to obtain a certified State of Michigan Waiver.

All payments are for a 4 week period and are prepaid accordingly to the published calendar. Families must attend a minimum of 2 days/week.

No extended care is available for these classes.

Payments are due at the end of August, October, January and March according to the published calendar.

## School Age Care

Children must attend 2-5 days/week.

All payments are for a 4 week period and are prepaid accordingly to the published calendar.
